

CLASS OF GRADUATE OUTCOMES

2024

Each year Harvard Graduate School of Education graduates highly competitive candidates into the job market in a variety of professional sectors. This report provides a snapshot of the 739 HGSE graduates to whom degrees were conferred in May 2024. Students were surveyed up to four months from their graduation date, with an 85% knowledge rate*, reflecting 706 master's, 24 doctoral, and 9 certificate of advanced study graduates.

*Knowledge rate is defined as basic information about career outcomes of graduates (either selfreported via the survey or administratively added from various third parties.)




